

## **Bad Weather Arrangement**

A) *For classes not yet started*

*For Black Storm Signal:*

<b>If Hong Kong Observatory announces the black storm signal</b>		
At or before 11:59am	All lessons before 2:00pm will be cancelled	All cancelled classes can be re-scheduled at a later time.
Between 12:00nn and 2:59pm	All lessons between 12:00nn and 5:00pm will be cancelled	
Between 3:00pm and 5:00pm	All lessons between 3:00pm and 7:30pm will be cancelled	

*For typhoon signal no.8 or above:*

<b>When typhoon signal no.8 or above is hoisted</b>		
At or before 11:59am and the signal is cancelled or lowered before 12:00nn	All lessons before 2:00pm will be cancelled. Lessons after 2:00pm will not be affected	All cancelled classes can be re-scheduled at a later time.
At or before 11:59am and the signal is not cancelled or lowered before 12:00nn	All lessons after the time of announcement will be cancelled	
After 12:00nn		
<b>When typhoon signal no.8 or above is announced by the Hong Kong Observatory to be hoisted within 2 hours:</b>		
At or before 11:59am and the signal is not cancelled or lowered before 12:00nn	All lessons after the time of announcement will be cancelled	All cancelled classes can be re-scheduled at a later time.
After 12:00nn		

B) *For classes already started*

*For both black storm signal and typhoon signal no.8 or above:*

<b>Classes will continue. After the end of classes:</b>	
Students who are over 18 years-old	can either leave on their own or stay in the centre until the front desk is closed.
Students who are under 18 years-old	need to seek their parents' consent that they can leave on their own.

When Typhoon Signal No.3 or Red Rainstorm Signal is hoisted, it should be assumed that all class(es) will be held as scheduled unless special announcement has been made (in which case students will be notified by phone).
